

Kingfisher Bushcraft Terms and Conditions

- Kingfisher Bushcraft operates a 'no drugs or alcohol' policy.
- Participants agree to observe all COVID 19 guidelines. DO NOT attend if you are suffering from any symptoms associated with COVID 19.
- In all classes, workshops, demonstrations and excursions conducted by Kingfisher Bushcraft all reasonable care will be taken to prevent serious injury and to minimize accidents.
- The PARTICIPANT agrees that they are fully aware that even under the safest conditions possible, workshops may contain an element of risk and danger, and the PARTICIPANT hereby agrees to accept full responsibility and assume all risks, including those caused by Acts of God, of injury, death, and/or loss to their person and/or property knowingly and voluntarily.
- The PARTICIPANT agrees to obey the rules and regulations Kingfisher Bushcraft puts in to effect to minimize these risks.
- Kingfisher Bushcraft reserves the right to remove any PARTICIPANT from any class, workshop, demonstration or excursion, if the PARTICIPANT'S conduct is abusive or inappropriate.
- The PARTICIPANT knowingly, voluntarily and irrevocably waives any and all past, present and/or future claims, demands and causes of action which the PARTICIPANT now has or may have in the future against all officers, employees, instructors, assistant instructors, volunteers, and/or other participants while on the premises of Kingfisher Bushcraft or premises hired to Kingfisher Bushcraft for the purposes of instruction, for any and all past, present, and/or future injuries, death, loss, including those caused by Acts of God, received while participating in activities conducted by Kingfisher Bushcraft, as a student, participant, spectator, and/ or visitor, or in any other manner or form, taking part in the exercises, practices, excursions, and/or demonstrations of bushcraft and outdoor living.
- Participants accept full responsibility for their belongings and in the event of loss, theft or damage Kingfisher Bushcraft accepts no liability.
- The PARTICIPANT certifies that they are physically, emotionally and mentally capable of participation in the said practices despite the rigors and possible dangers inherent in such an undertaking.
- Kingfisher Bushcraft reserves the right to alter times, dates and content of courses if this becomes necessary and will endeavour to inform relevant parties as soon as practicable. In the event of a course cancellation, a full refund will be given. Alternatively, the course fee can be reallocated to another Kingfisher Bushcraft course.
- The PARTICIPANT accepts that bookings must be made at least 2 weeks prior to the appropriate course commencement date, and must be accompanied by payment of the course fee in full, unless otherwise agreed by Kingfisher Bushcraft in writing.
- The PARTICIPANT is aware that a booking cancellation by the PARTICIPANT, for any reason, will incur the forfeit of 50% of the course fee. In the event that a class, workshop, demonstration or excursion conducted by Kingfisher Bushcraft is cancelled, a full refund of the course fee will be offered.
- The course fee can be reallocated to another course one time only if cancellation by the PARTICIPANT is 2 weeks prior to the course for which it was originally intended. Cancellation after 2 weeks prior to the commencement of the course for any reason, will incur the forfeit of 50% of the course fee.
